Celebrate the Harvest with local wine and food pairing!

Niagara County, NY – September 23-25, the members of the Niagara Wine Trail will celebrate the beginning of harvest with their annual Harvest Festival Weekend event.

Each winery has selected a food from a local vendor to pair with one of their wines. Harvest activities, such as grape stomping, will be available at some wineries along with live music. A list of each winery's wine and food pairing and activity is online at www.niagarawinetrail.org. Cheese pairing for the event is provided by Yancey's Fancy Artisan Cheeses.

Reserved tickets are \$20/person plus tax and are available online through September 23. Tickets will be available at the door during the event for \$25/person plus tax. The ticket includes a wine glass at the starting winery, wine tasting at each of the 14 participating wineries and the food pairing and autumn activities. Tickets are good for all three days of the event. Friday hours are Noon until 6 pm, Saturday 10 AM until 6 PM and Sunday from noon until 6 pm.
