Niagara County, NY – The Niagara Wine Trail’s “Share the Bounty” event was held this past November 15th & 16th. The annual event helps to raise food and monetary donations for the local food banks in Niagara and Orleans counties and it was once again a great success. Participants traveled among the twelve member wineries and helped to raise over 2,200 food items and over \$1,000 in monetary donations for the food banks. “This is a very important yearly event for us,” says Jackie Connolly, proprietor of Niagara Landing Wine Cellars, “it is a time for all of us to give back and to be thankful for all that we have.” Wine tasting at each winery during the event was \$2.50 or a canned good donation per person. All proceeds and food donations raised from the event went directly to local food banks such as the Salvation Army Food Bank of Lockport and the Newfane Community Food Pantry at St. Brendans.
